



Visitors To The House

For everyone's health and safety, public visits to Scott Manor House will be in accordance with all public health protocols. COVID-19 measures are in place, nonetheless, visiting is **at your own risk**.

Visitors will be allowed to view exhibits, tour the House or have tea in the Tea Room. All visitors must adhere to the following:

- All COVID-19 (coronavirus) precautions must be followed during your visit.
- Masks (nonmedical face coverings) **are** required at all times during your visit.
- A representative of the Fort Sackville Foundation will guide you through your visit.
- You are required to provide your name, telephone number and if possible, your email address.
- Physical distancing is recommended during the entire visit. Respect any health and safety instructions given by your host.
- Use hand sanitizer when you enter and leave the building.
- Do not touch the objects on display.
- Do not visit – stay at home if:
 - you are feeling unwell;
 - you have symptoms of coronavirus; or
 - you are required to self-isolate for any reason.
 - Reasons for self-isolation include (at the time of writing and subject to change)
 - you have COVID-19 symptoms; or
 - you have tested positive for COVID-19.
